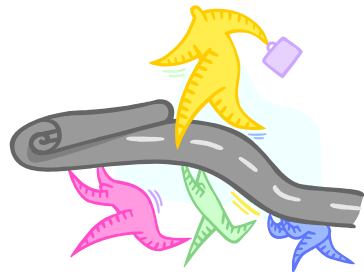

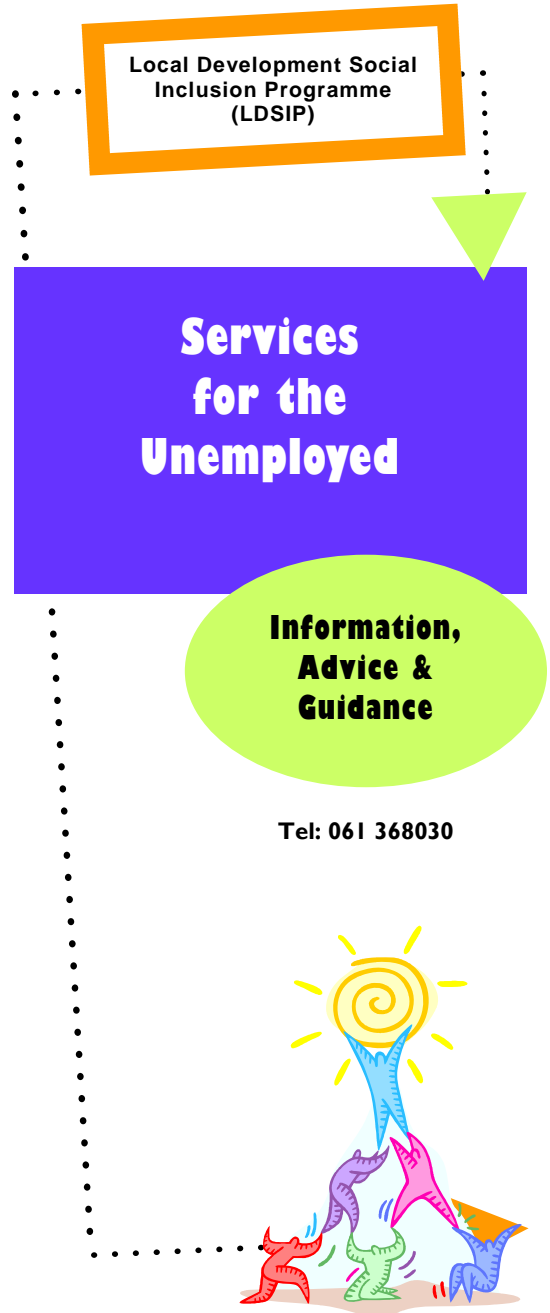

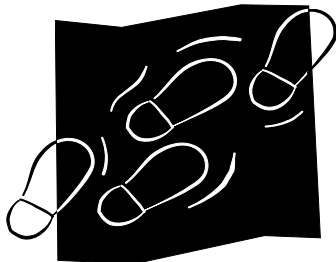

Support Services

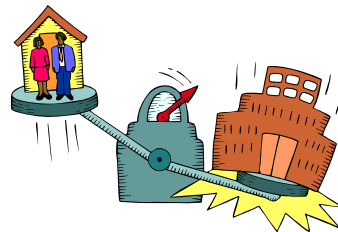
Obair LDSIP provides the following service:

- Career information, advice & guidance
- Explore employment, training & education options
- One to one career guidance to help you discover your interests and skills & match these skills to potential careers
- CV preparation and assistance with job searching
- Follow up support
- Referral to other services where relevant

Looking to return to education

If you are thinking about returning to education as an adult, we can help you. The LDSIP can support people who meet the eligibility criteria and who are returning to full-time education. The support can be in the form of help towards course fees and expenses, travel or childcare costs.

Adult Training Programmes

Obair LDSIP facilitates the provision of adult education programmes locally, to find out what is currently available in the local area contact the LDSIP office.

The Obair Local Development Social Inclusion Programme is a government funded programme designed to support eligible groups and individuals. If you feel that you qualify, contact us and we can discuss ways in which the programme can help you, whether its returning to work, education or training.

Who is eligible for Support

The range of groups and individuals eligible for support under the LDSIP are:

- Long-term and short-term unemployed
- Under-employed i.e. seasonal workers
- Women who are socially and economically disadvantaged
- Lone Parents who are socially and economically disadvantaged
- Travellers
- Disabled People
- Young people, who have left school early
